Entry 47a FS D.A. I.A. D. 16. 1710

Interpretation: Flat (through) stone

Entry 47b (next 47a) 1840. Alex Anderson fr Cultullich 22.2.1833 88th, w Margt MacLagan 10.11.1859 73, da Margt 8.1.1822 26th, only s Donald Anderson alias MacLagan d Perth 16.7.1833 32ndy. (west side) 8-line verse.

Interpretation: Alexander Anderson, farmer, Cultullich died 22 Feb 1833 aged 88yrs; wife Margaret MacLagan died 10 Nov 1859 aged 73yrs; daughter Margaret died 8 Jan 1822 aged 26yrs; only son Donald Anderson alias MacLagan died at Perth 16 Jul 1833 aged 32yrs.

Entry 47c (next 47b) Alex Anderson bootmaker Aberfeldy 21.8.1877 53, w Isabella McGregor 13.6.1895 73, s Robt 13.7.1922 67

Interpretation: Alexander Anderson bootmaker Aberfeldy died 21 Aug 1877 aged 53yrs; wife Isabella McGregor died 13 Jun 1895 aged 73yrs; son Robert died 13 Jul 1922 aged 67yrs
