London Diocese 10 Aug 1798 appeared personally George Barker of the parish of Isleworth, a batchelor aged upwards of twenty one years intendeth to intermarry with Mary Turner of the same place, spinster also aged upwards of twenty one years and prayed a Licence to solmenize the same in the Parish Church of Isleworth and further made oath that the usual place of abode of him the appearer hath been the said parish of Isleworth. Signed George Barker.

Know all Men by these presents that we George Barker of the parish of Isleworth and John Doe are hereby become bound unto the Right Reverend Father in God, Beilby, by Divine Permission, Lord Bishop of London in the Sum of Two Hundred Pounds of good and lawful money of Great Britain to be paid to him... for the good and faithful payment of which sum we do bind ourselves, and both of us, jointly and severally... 10 Aug 1798. The Condition of this Obligation is such... that George Barker a batchelor and Mary Turner a spinster may lawfully solemnize Marriage together...
