On Saturday morning last the wife of Mr Ralph Bulliman, of Newnham, in this County, was safely delivered of four children viz. three girls and one boy. Two of the girls, with the Mother, are in a fair Way of doing well.

*Northampton Mercury 13 May 1837 Death*  
Lately, at Daventry, in the 55th year of his age, deeply lamented by his family and friends, Mr Bulliman, landlord of the King's Head Inn.

*Lincolnshire Chronicle 18 Aug 1837 Death*

A short time ago, at Daventry, in his 56<sup>th</sup> year, Mr Bulliman, for 24 years landlord of the King's Head inn, eldest son of the late Mr Ralph Bulliman, of Newnham, and of Ewerby Thorpe, Lincolnshire.

Lately, at Heckington, near Sleaford, Lincolnshire, aged 91, much respected by all who knew him, Mr Lester, brother-in-law to Mrs Bulliman, of Newnham, near Daventry. Six deaths have occurred in this family within about four months.

*Northampton Mercury 02 Mar 1844*

On Thursday last an inquest was held at Staverton, before Mr Hicks, Deputy Coroner, on the body of Thomas Bulliman, a carrier of that place. It appeared that on Wednesday the deceased went to Rugby with his cart, accompanied by his two daughters, that he transacted his business there, and appeared quite well. Upon their return home deceased complained of cold, and asked one of his daughters to drive, and he then got into the cart and lay down. When they arrived at Daventry his daughters asked him if he would get out, and he replied, "No, he was warm and comfortable." The deceased's wife and daughter then got into the cart and drove home, and upon their arrival it was discovered that he was dead. Mr Sharman, of Daventry, surgeon, was immediately sent for, and he was of opinion that deceased died of apoplexy. Verdict accordingly.

Death notice: On the 28<sup>th</sup> ultimo, suddenly, while returning home in his cart from Daventry market, Mr T. Bulliman, carrier, of Staverton.

*Northampton Mercury 05 Apr 1884 Staverton – Sudden Death*

Mr Terry held an inquest at the Windmill on Tuesday on the body of Mary Ann Bulliman, 52 years of age, the wife of William Bulliman, carrier. It appeared from the evidence of her husband that she had been subject to fits, but she was as well as usual when she went to bed at nine o'clock on Sunday night. Some time later her husband was awoke and found deceased in an epileptic fit. He did what he could, and called in Sarah Ann Feathers, a neighbour. She, however, died at an early hour on Monday morning. Mr Johnson, surgeon, Daventry, gave it as his opinion that the cause of death was rupture of the vessel at the base of the brain during an epileptic attack. A verdict was returned accordingly.
