Evening Post 18 Dec 1888 Our Wairarapa Letter

The Wairarapa Gun Club held a pigeon shooting match at Tauherenikau racecourse, near Featherston, on Saturday. The shooting took place in a lovely paddock, and the day being suitable it was a most enjoyable occasion. The Messrs Bidwill (3), C. Elgar, L. Pharazyn, F. Burt, W. Still and A. McKenzie were among the competitors, and there were a goodly number of lookers on. Messrs J. Bidwill and F. Burt were the victors. Mr Wilkinson, the landlord of the Tauherenikau Hotel, supplied the creature comforts, and the birds which came out in the s.s. 'Ionic' recently were strong on the wing, and not very easy to shoot.

N. Burt, of South Featherston. The bride was given away by her father. Miss Maude Ashworth, sister of the bride, was bridesmaid, and Mr Ernest Yule was best man. The Rev G. K. Stowell was the officiating minister.
