No. 965 Chest, angels with trumpets on sides. In memory of Johanna Clay wife of John Clay died 2 Dec 1804 aged 37yrs. Also John Clay died 12 Dec 1847 aged 82yrs. Also William eldest son of the above died 13 May 1852 aged 57yrs. Jessie Young relict of William Clay died at Portobello 16 Nov 1874 aged 73yrs. Also Sarah youngest dau of John Clay died 12 Feb 1880 aged 80yrs.
