Ellen WREN died 03 Apr 1883 aged 26yrs. Spouse Joseph WREN, M.A. and George Francis Basil WREN died 16 Apr 1883, infant of Rev Joseph and Ellen WREN. Buried Hamilton St Peter's Anglican. Also plaque in church – Ouse St John the Baptist, Anglican, Hamilton, Hobart

Birth: On the 31st March, at Franklin Villa, Hamilton-on-Clyde, Tasmania, the wife of the Rev. Joseph Wren, prematurely, of a son.

Death 1: On the 3rd April, at Franklin Villa, Hamilton-on-Clyde, Tasmania, Ellen, wife of the Rev. Joseph Wren, and youngest daughter of the late Francis Drake Esq., of Jersey and Newcastle-upon-Tyne, and sister of Fanny Drake, of Biarritz, aged twenty-six.

Death 2: On the 16th April, at Hamilton-on-Clyde, Tasmania, George Francis Basil, infant son of the Rev. Joseph Wren, aged sixteen days.
