### *1871-1872 Wellington Country Electoral Roll*

### *1874-1875 Egmont Electoral Roll*

### *Evening Post 24 Sep 1874 New Plymouth 23<sup>rd</sup> September*

Mr Drake, of Wellington, has bought Dingle's farm, at Ahuahu, at £3 10s per acre.

### *Taranaki Herald 21 Oct 1874 Notice*

Trespassers found cutting or removing any timber off Section Nos. 37, 38, 39, 40, 89, 90, and 91 (Oakura Block), will be prosecuted. Also, stock running on the above sections after this date will be impounded. Thomas J. Drake. Ahuahu, October 19, 1874.

### *Taranaki Herald 1 May 1875 Notice*

Persons removing Cattle &c from my place at Ahuahu without permission will be prosecuted; and Cattle grazing thereon will be charged for at the rate of 2s per head per week. T. G. Drake.

### *Taranaki Herald 1 Sep 1875 Birth*

On the 22<sup>nd</sup> August, at Ahuahu, the wife of T. J. Drake, of a son.

### *Taranaki Herald 18 Oct 1876 Death*

On the 26<sup>th</sup> September, Walter Wellington, son of Thomas John Drake, Oakura, aged 13 months.

### *Taranaki Herald 9 May 1879 Electoral District of the Town of New Plymouth*

The following persons are objected to as not being entitled to have their names retained on the List of Voters for the Electoral District of the Town of New Plymouth:- ... Thomas Drake, residing at New Plymouth, Supposed leasehold qualification. Ground of objection – No qualification.

*Taranaki Herald 23 Aug 1881 Land Transfer Act Notice*

Notice is hereby given that the several parcels of Land hereinafter described will be brought under the provisions of "The Land Transfer Act, 1870," unless caveat be lodged forbidding the same within one calendar month from the date of the *Gazette* containing this notice:- ...Thomas John Drake, Applicant – 152 acres 3 roods (more or less), comprising Rural Allotments 89,90, and 91, Oakura District...
