Brighton Patriot and South of England Free Press 23 Jul 1839

Directors and Guardians' Meeting, Workhouse, Wednesday, July 17, 1839 – Mr Tugwell in the Chair.

The Clerk presented the Visiting Committee's report, which certified that they had examined the Governor's cash account, amounting to... 6s 11d., and found the same to be correct. It also recommended that the north wall of the new building should be compeed down to the ventilator, that the Governor's room should be re-painted, and the cister, repaired. The report was adopted, and a cheque drawn in favour of the Governor for the above-named amount. Cheques were severally drawn for £90 in favour of the Assistant Overseer for relief of the poor; £3 to Edward Chatfield, for first instalment of an apprentice premium; £338 3s 6d for R. Patching, Jun., for 250½ tons of Hetton's Lyon coals, delivered at the Workhouse, per contract; and Mr Bartlett, travelling expenses, £10 17s 6d. The Clerk read a communication from [Mr John Elliott, of Lewes](#), relative to the application of George Akehurst, to emigrate to South Australia, with two children, intimating that the applicant might be ensured a passage for about £22. The board unanimously resolved, without discussion, that the application could not be entertained.
