I Samuel Fletcher of Gravesend in the county of Kent Victualler to hereby give devise and bequeath unto my dear wife Elizabeth Fletcher her heirs exors admons and assigns all my real and personal estate of every description whatsoever and I do appoint my said wife executrix of this my will dated the 8th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen. Signed Samuel Fletcher. Signed sealed published pronounced and declared by the said Samuel Fletcher as his last will and testament in the presence of us who in his presence and by his desire and consent and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names Richard Raspison, John Rawlings. Proved at London 19th March 1814 before the Judge by the oath of Elizabeth Fletcher widow the Relict & sole extrux to whom admon was granted having been first sworn duly to administer.
