This is to give notice, that by an indenture, bearing date the 12th day of May 1848, and made between William Archer, of the borough of Gravesend, in the county of Kent, Builder and Publican, of the first part; William Fletcher, of the same borough, Coal Merchant, Giles Symonds, of the same borough, Ironmonger, and Charles Smith Williamson, of the same borough, Gentleman, of the second part; and the several other persons (creditors of the said William Archer) who by themselves, their partners, agents, or attorneys, have affixed or shall affix their hands and seals to the same indenture, of the third part; the said William Archer hath conveyed and assigned all his real and personal estate and effects whatsoever to the said William Fletcher, Giles Symonds, and Charles Smith Williamson, as trustees, upon trust, for the benefit of all the creditors of the said William Archer who shall execute the said indenture within six calendar months from the date thereof; and that the said indenture was duly executed by William Archer on the said 12th day of May instant, and by the said William Fletcher, Giles Symonds, and Charles Smith Williamson, on the 15th day of May instant; and the execution of the said indenture by the said William Archer, William Fletcher, Giles Symonds, and Charles Smith Williamson, was attested by George Edward Sharland, of the borough of Gravesend, aforesaid, Attorney at Law. – Dated this 22nd day of May 1848.
