Baptism Register for St Nicholas, Rochester, Kent 1742

William son of Mr William Gates by Frances his wife was baptised the 19th of September 1742

Banns Register for St Werburgh Hoo, Kent 1773

Banns of Marriage between William Gates and Ann Siers both of this parish were published on the three Sundays underwritten: That is to say, On Sunday, the 10th of January, on Sunday the 17th January, on Sunday the 24th January 1773 by me J. Youde.

Marriage Register for St Werburgh Hoo, Kent 1773 – Entry No. 86

William Gates of this parish bachelor and Ann Siers of the same spinster were married in this church by Banns this 26th day of January in the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy three by me J. Youde. This marriage was solmenized between us William Gates and Ann Siers her mark in the presence of John Morley and Elizabeth Barney.
