I Aaron Green of the Town of Ware in the County of Hertford Gentleman do make and publish this to be my last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say I give and devise all that my messuage or tenement and farm with the outhouses lands grounds and appurtenances thereunto belonging as well freehold as copyhold the copyhold part whereof I have surrendered to the use of my wife situate lying and being in the parishes of Thorley and Sabridgeworth or one of them in the County of Hertford and now in the occupation of Daniel Samford unto and to the use of **my dear wife Susanna Green** and her assigns for and during the term of her natural life without impeachment of or for any manner of waste voluntary waste in pulling down the said messuage or other buildings and not rebuilding the same only excepted and from and after the death of my said wife I give and devise the said messuage farm lands grounds and premises with the appurtenances unto and to the use of **my son James Green** his heirs and assigns for ever also I give and devise all that my close of arable land called Six Acre Close with the appurtenances which I purchased of John Chauncy [...] lying within the Parish of Ware aforesaid unto and to the use of my said wife Susanna Green and her assigns for and during the term of her natural life without impeachment of or for any manner of waste and from and after the death of my said wife I give and devise my said Close of land with the appurtenances unto and to the use of **my son John Green** his heirs and assigns for ever also I give and bequeath all my household goods and furniture plate silver china books and also my Chaise and horses unto my said wife for her own use and benefit also I give and bequeath unto my said wife Susanna Green and my said sons James Green and John Green the sum of two thousand pounds of lawful money of Great Britain On Trust with the consent and approbation of **my son in law Nathaniel Stonard and my daughter Susanna his wife** and of the survivor of them testified under their his or her hands or hand in writing and in the case of both their deaths then of the proper authority of my said Trustees or the survivor or survivors of them to place the same out at interest in the names of them my said Trustees on Government or other public stocks funds or securities with full liberty power and authority to sell out alter or change such securities and place out the money arising therefrom upon new or other securities of the like kind from time to time as they my said Trustees or the survivors or survivor of them with such consent as aforesaid or of their his or her own authority as the case may happen shall think

fit and proper and upon further Trust that my said Trustees and the survivors and survivor of them and the executors and administrators of such survivor do and shall pay to or authorise and empower my said daughter Susanna Stonard to receive and take the Annual Interest and Dividends of the said stocks funds and securities from time to time as the same shall become due and payable during the term of her natural life which I direct shall be for her own sole and separate use and benefit and not to be subject or liable to the control debts or engagements of the said Nathaniel Stonard or any future husband she may marry and the receipts and directions of my said daughter notwithstanding her present or any future coverture shall be from time to time sufficient discharge for such Interest and Dividends or for so much thereof as in such receipt or scrip shall be expressed or acknowledged to be received and from and after the death of my said daughter in case the said Nathaniel Stonard shall her survive On Trust to pay to or authorize and empower him the said Nathaniel Stonard and his assigns to receive and take the said Interest and Dividends from time to time as the same shall from thenceforth become due and payable during the term of his natural life and from and after the death of the survivor of the said Nathaniel Stonard and Susanna his wife then as far and concerning the principal or capital of the said stocks funds and securities and the interest and dividends from thenceforth to arise due thereon On Trust for all and every or each one or more of the Child or Children of my said daughter lawfully [..ing] whether by the said Nathaniel Stonard or any future husband she may marry for such rights and interests and in such parts shares and proportions manner and form either absolutely or conditionally and to be paid or transferred at such day days or times as she my said daughter by her last Will and Testament in writing or any writing purporting to be her last Will and Testament to be by her signed and published in the presence of and attested by two or more credible witnesses notwithstanding her present or any future coverture shall direct or appoint and in default of such direction or appointment or in case there shall be any such then when and so soon as the Rights and Interests so to be appointed shall determine and as for and concerning so much of the said stocks funds or securities whereof no such direction or appointment shall be made On Trust for all or every the child or children of my said daughter whether by the said Nathaniel Stonard or any future husband lawfully espousing equally to be divided between them if more than one share and share alike and if there shall be but one such child then On Trust for such only child the part or share of [..] such child being a son to be transferred and paid to or become vested in him at the age of twenty one years and being a daughter at her age of twenty one years or day of marriage which shall first happen and upon further Trust to pay and apply theyearly interest and dividends of such childs part and share becoming due after the death of the survivor of the said Nathaniel Stonard and Susanna his wife in the meantime and until such share shall become payable or transferable as aforesaid or so much thereof as the said Trustees or the survivors or survivor of them shall think fit for or towards his or her maintenance and education and to lay out the residue thereof if any on such securities as aforesaid to accumulate for the benefit of each such child from whose share the same shall arise and my will is that in case any one or more of the sons of my said daughter shall die under the age of twenty one years or any one or more of her daughters shall die under the said age and unmarried then the share or shares of him or her or them so dying of and in the said Trust funds and securities and the accumulations therefrom shall go belong and accrue to the survivors or survivor or others or other of the children of my said daughter and the executors and administrators of such of them as shall be dead having first acquired a vested interest in his or her or their original share or shares and be equally divided between them if more than one share and share alike and the same shall be payable or transferable at such respective ages days and times as I have hereinbefore declared touching his her or their original share or shares and such benefit of survivorship or accrual shall extend as well to the surviving or accruing as to the original share or shares and in case my said daughter shall have no child or children or having such they shall all die before the age or time aforesaid then my will is that the whole of the said stocks funds and securities and accumulations of interest if any shall go and belong to **my four sons James Green John Green Edward Green and Thomas Green** and be equally divided between them share and share alike and their respective executors and administrators as vested interests but nevertheless in case my said son Thomas Green shall be under the age of twenty one years his share thereof shall go and be equally divided between his brothers the said James Green John Green and Edward Green and their respective executors and administrators as vested interests

also I give unto my said son James Green the sum of five thousand pounds of lawful money of Great Britain and unto my said son John Green the sum of two thousand pounds of like lawful money and unto my said son Edward Green the sum of two thousand pounds of like money also I give unto my said son Thomas Green the sum of five thousand pounds of like lawful money but in case my said son Thomas Green shall at the time of my death be under the age of twenty one years then I direct that my executors hereinafter named shall lay out and invest the same on Government or other public stocks shares or securities or on [...] securities with full liberty and power for them or the survivors or survivor of them to alter transpose and change the same and lay out the money arising therefrom on such or the like securities as aforesaid from time to time as they shall think fit and that they my said executors do and shall transfer or assign the same unto my said son Thomas Green when and so soon as he shall attain the age of twenty one years and do and shall in the meantime pay or apply the interest or dividends thereof or so much thereof as they shall think fit for his maintenance or otherwise for his benefit and advantage and lay out the residue thereof at interest on such securities as aforesaid to accumulate for his benefit and to be paid or transferred to him at the same time with the said funds or securities in which his said legacy of five thousand pounds shall be invested but in case my said son Thomas Green shall die under the age of twenty one years then I give and bequeath the said stock funds and securities in which his said legacy shall be invested and all the accumulations of interest therefrom unto my said sons James Green John Green and Edward Green and my said daughter Susanna Stonard equally to be divided between them share and share alike and their respective executors and administrators and I confirm the several portions or gifts I have heretofore advanced or given to or for the benefit of my said children declaring it to be my intention that they shall respectively have and retain the same over and besides the provisions I have made for them by this my Will also I give unto the said Nathaniel Stonard one hundred pounds for the trouble he must necessarily have as one of my executors and I direct that the several pecuniary legacies aforesaid shall be paid or laid out within six calendar months next after my death also I give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my personal estate and effects whatsoever and wheresoever and of what nature kind or quality [...] which I am now or shall at my death be possessed of interested in or intitled to or over which I have a disposing power unto my said wife Susanna Green her executors administrators and assigns for her and their own use and benefit absolutely and for ever and my will is that in case any or either of my Trustees or Executor before named or any future Trustees in whom any of the Trust funds or securities aforesaid shall be vested shall die or desire to be discharged before the trusts aforesaid are performed then and in such case and from time to time as the same shall so happen the surviving or [...] shall and may nominate and appoint one or more new Trustee or Trustees in the room of him or them so dying or desiring to be discharged from the said trusts and thereupon the said trust funds and securities respectively shall from time to time be assigned or transferred so as to vest the same in the then surviving or continuing Trustees or Trustee and in such new Trustees or Trustee jointly or in such new Trustees wholly as the case shall happen upon the trusts and for the intents and purposes hereinbefore declared concerning the said Trust funds and securities respectively but my will is that no new Trustee or Trustees be appointed during the life of the said Nathaniel Stonard and Susanna his wife or the life of the survivor of them as to the funds and securities in which they are interested without their consent or the consent of such survivor under their his or her hands or hand and my will also is that no Trustee of any of the funds or securities aforesaid shall be answerable for any [...] thereof or any money arising therefrom than shall actually [...] to his or her hands nor for any involuntary loss that may happen by the placing out changing or replacing the same on such securities as aforesaid nor shall either of them be chargeable with the acts deeds receipts or defaults of the other or others of them but only for his or her own act receipt or default only and that it shall be lawful for any Trustee at all times to reimburse and pay himself and herself out of the respective Trust monies funds and securities all costs charges and expenses that he or she shall be put to by means of such Trusts respectively and lastly I appoint my said wife Susanna Green my said sons James Green and John Green and my son in law the said Nathaniel Stonard Executrix and Executors of this my Will and do hereby revoke all former and other Wills by me made In Witness whereof I the said Aaron Green the Testator to this my last Will and Testament contained in four sheets of paper have set my hand to the three first sheets thereof and to this fourth being the last sheet thereof I have set my

hand and seal the Eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight Aaron Green () signed sealed published and declared by the above named Aaron Green the Testator as and for his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who in his presence and in the presence of each other have subscribed our names as Witnesses thereof the word February in the date being first interlined Ja. Hall Poultry [...] Clerks to Mr Hall

This Will was proved at London the eighteenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and six before the worshipful [...] Phillimore Doctor of Laws and Surrogate of the Right Honourable Sir William [...] Knight also Doctor of Laws Master [...] or Commissary of the Prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the oaths of Susanna Green Widow the Relict of the deceased James Green and John Green the sons of the deceased and Nathaniel Stonard the Executors named in the said Will to whom administration was granted of all and singular the Goods Chattels and [...] of the said deceased they having been first sworn duly to administer.
