Headstone located in Section V Row H Number 13: Sacred to the Memory of Emma eldest daughter of Thomas & Mary Green of Thorley Wash who died July 27th 1837 aged 12 years. Also two other of their daughters Harriet died Sept 17, 1834 aged 3 years; Jane died June 17th 1837 aged 18 days. At the foot of the headstone: EG 1837 / HG 1831 / JG 1837.
