The Times 26 Nov 1908 p13 Obituary
Colonel James Shrubbs Iredell, Bombay Staff Corps, whose death is announced as having taken place at Heathcot, Tavistock-road, Croyden, on the 23rd inst., at the age of 70, was gazetted to the Indian Army in December, 1856. He took part in the operations at the time of the Mutiny in 1857-8, serving at Shorepore and Nurgood, and against the Dessaies in the Sawount-Waree district. In 1868 he was promoted to Captain and in 1876 to Major, and in the Afghan war of 1879-80 he took part in the action at Ghirisk and was severely wounded at the battle of Maiwand. For his services he was mentioned in despatches and received the medal. In December, 1882, he was promoted to Lieutenant-Colonel, and in October, 1886 retired with the honorary rank of Colonel.
