Baptismal Register of the Scotch Church Southwark 1829-1830

Isabella Hamilton, daughter of Peter Morrisson, Currier, and Margaret his wife, born the thirteenth day of December one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine at No.11 Virginia Terrace Dover Road, St Mary Newington and baptised the twentieth January one thousand eight hundred and thirty. James Mullor.

The Probate granted by the Prerogative Court of Canterbury September 1842 having been impounded. Effects under £12,000.

Letters of Administration (with the Will annexed) of the Personal estate and effects of Peter Morrison late of 11 Virginia-terrace Great-Dover-road in the County of Surrey Leather Merchant deceased who died 14 January 1841 at Virginia-terrace aforesaid were granted at the Principal Registry under certain Specialities to John Morrison of 3 Adelaide-place London Bridge in the City of London Merchant the Administrator (with Will) of the Personal estate and effects of Margaret Morrison Widow the Relict and sole Executrix of the Will of the said Deceased for the Use and Benefit of John Hubback the surviving Executor of the Will of the said Margaret Morrison he the said John Morrison having been first sworn. Former Grant Prerogative Court of Canterbury February 1841. Effects under £20,000.
