Page 20 Election Day

“The poll took place on 3 October 1842. The voters were free to record their support for anyone they chose to name, with or without the nominee’s consent. As a result there were 59 nominees but of these 20 received only one vote and nine others less than ten votes. Four thousand votes were polled and Burgesses could each vote for up to 18 candidates.” Francis Alexander Molesworth was the only “Hutt” nominee.

Account by Edward Jerningham Wakefield

“... that all male inhabitants should be entitled to register their votes with the sub-sheriff by paying one pound sterling each... The usual competition took place between the gentry and the working men. Each party formed a committee which suggested a list of Alderman for election, held meetings and canvassed votes. The canvassing began even before the registry of voters, for the two parties paid the registry fee of many of the electors...the straw hut inside the pa, generally used as a Police Office” was used as the booth of the Returning Officer, Michael Murphy.

Appendix “B”

The Burgess Roll lists every male inhabitant of a Borough of full age who pays £1 to the returning officer and makes application in writing. [Registration closed 29 August 1842]

Appendix “C”

Total number of Burgesses = 352. There were 35 “Hutt” Burgesses and of these 25 are known to have participated in the poll. Six recorded the maximum 18 choices and a total of 275 “Hutt” votes were cast out of a total of ~4,000. A few votes are missing due to the latter part of the register recording the voting details being illegible due to damage. No details were recorded for 27 burgesses and 10 of these were from the Hutt.

Results of Arrival Ship analysis

Nominees or candidates who arrived on the ship ‘Oriental’ received 15% of “Hutt” votes.
Hutt burgesses who arrived on the ship ‘Lady Nugent’ cast 28% of “Hutt” votes.

The Hutt choice for Wellington’s first Mayor was William Fitzherbert.

New Zealand Gazette 07 Sep 1842

The Committee appointed at a late Public Meeting, for the purpose of forwarding the Election of those gentlemen who have been generally approved of by the community at large, beg to caution all parties from being misled by those self-elected individuals, who so very modestly advertised their names in the *Colonist* of last Friday. The following gentlemen only have been recognized by the public as the most fit and proper to form our first Town Council. Messrs Hunter, Wade, Molesworth, Revans, Dorset, Waitt, Cooper, E. Johnson, H. Taylor, Lyon, Hanson, A. Hort, McHattie, W. Smith, Catchpool, Wallace, Fitzherbert, R. Davis. The Committee meet at the Thistle Inn every Monday, and at the New Zealander every Thursday evenings, at eight o'clock. Signed J. Sutton, Chairman to Committee and dated 06 September 1842.

New Zealand Gazette and Wellington Spectator 07 Sep 1842

Borough of Wellington. The Committee for securing the Election of the following gentlemen, as Members of Council for this Borough, sit every Monday evening, between the hours of 7 and 9, at the Ship Hotel, Manners Street. Messrs Bethune, Daniell, Fitzherbert, Guyton, A. Hort, Hunter, E. Johnson, Ludlam, Durie, Lyon, McDonald, Molesworth, Partridge, Penny, W. A. Smith, Waitt, H. Wallace, Watt. Signed Henry St. Hill, Chairman of Committee and dated 6 September 1842.

New Zealand Gazette and Wellington Spectator 17 Sep 1842 Public Meeting

A Public Meeting of Burgesses took place at Barrett's Hotel on Wednesday last, at eight o'clock P.M., in terms of an advertisement, which appeared in the Gazette of that day... the object... was to hear the report of the Working Men's Committee... Mr Sutton, Chairman of the Committee proceeded to read the report... the Committee on being appointed immediately proceeded to wait upon the eighteen nominees individually, and with the exceptions... they had found them agreeable, and willing to put in nomination as Councilmen, and prepared to pledge themselves to vote for, and support exclusively, the gentlemen whose names formed the list now brought forward by Mr Sutton... Mr Sutton went on to state that the meeting of this evening would require to name five new nominees, in place of the following gentlemen:- Messrs Waitt, Hort, E. Wallace, W. M. Smith and Revans, whose names required to be struck off the Working-men's list, for the following specific causes. 1st. Messrs Waitt and Hort on being called on by the Committee, had refused to pledge themselves to the List then presented to them. Mr E. Wallace and Capt. Smith were necessarily occasionally absent from the Town on business; and Mr Revans was disqualified in consequence of the omission of his name on the Burgess roll, that gentleman having been unfortunately at Nelson when the roll was made up, and closed in terms of the Ordinance issued by the Auckland Government. The names of the five new nominees were... Messrs Pharyzan, Penny, Featherston, Scott and H. Wallace...

Account by Edward Jerningham Wakefield

Placards, advertisements, electioneering cards and squibs were in as great profusion as on the occasion of a contested election for a borough in England. On the day of the poll, flags and a band of music paraded the beach with some of the popular candidates; distinctive cockades were worn... agents of both parties were eager to force cards with their own list into the hands of each voter as he arrived. All the usual tricks and intrigues were resorted to; and bribery in the shape of glasses of grog was largely at work... but notwithstanding many such tricks, the "Gentry" secured a very good Council, and the Aldermen might be held to represent the community very fairly.

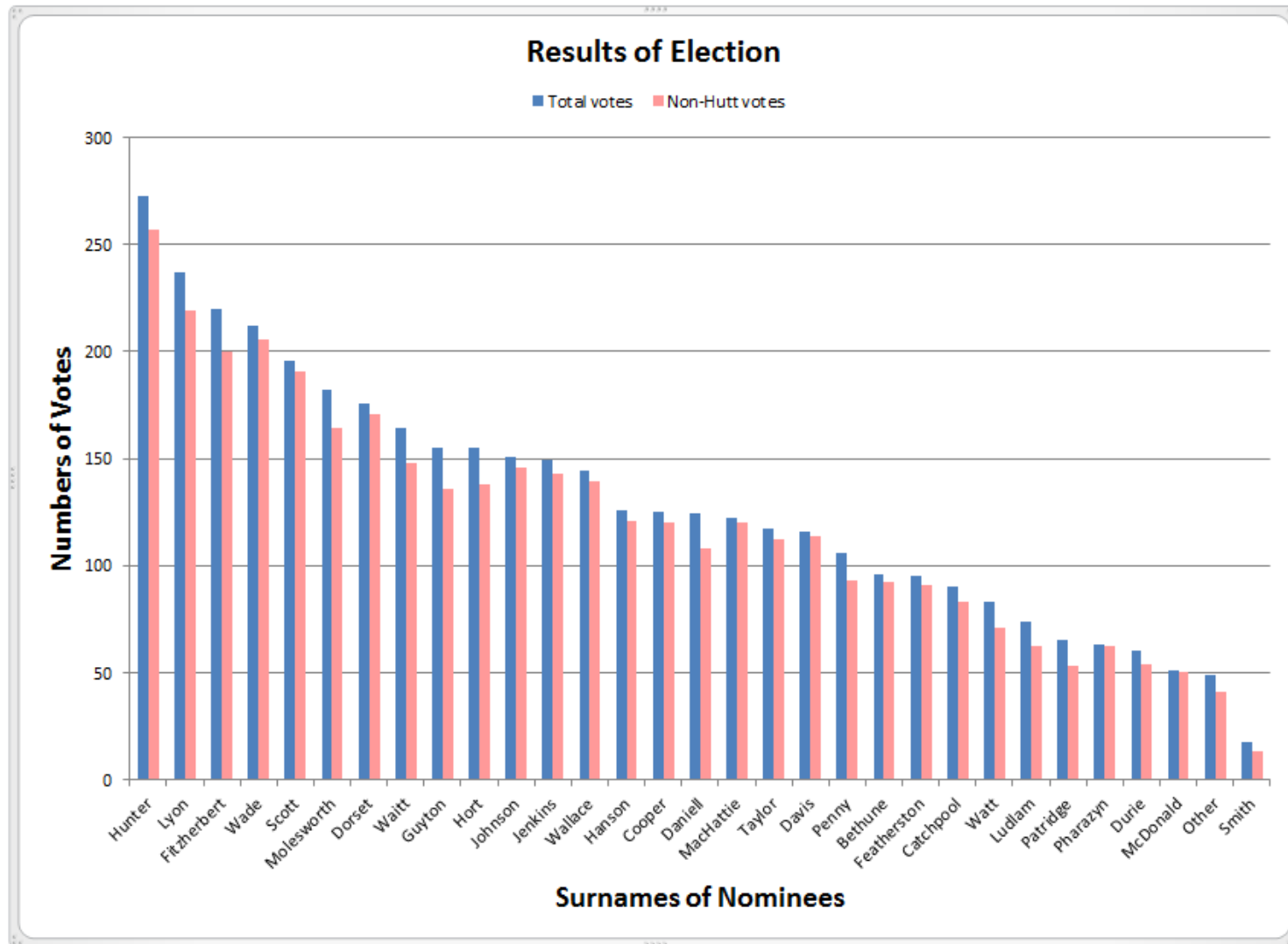

October 4, 1842. 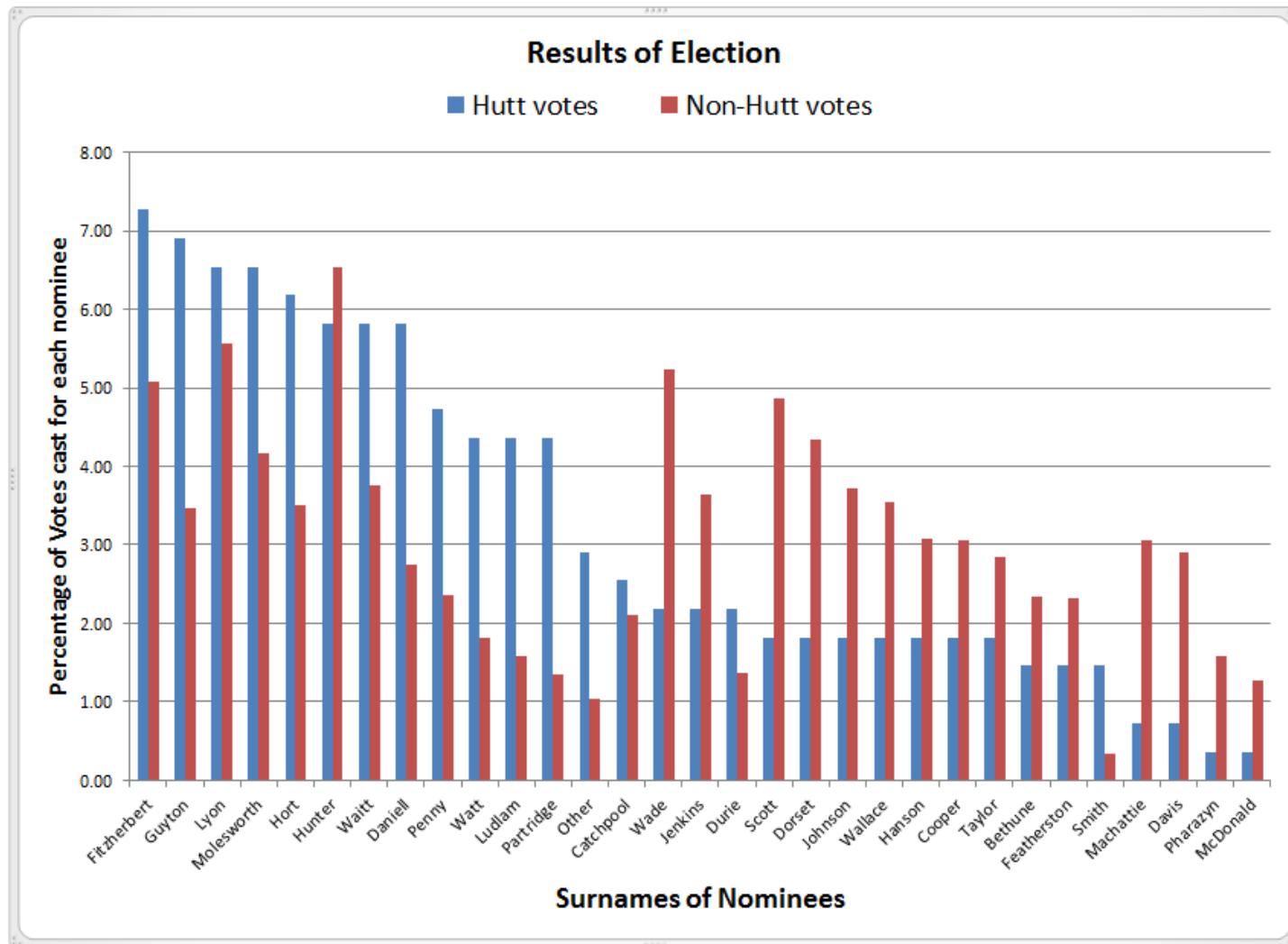

And I do hereby further declare... those whose names stand next highest upon the said List, shall form the *Reserved List*, out of which all extraordinary vacancies in the Council, until the next General Election thereof, shall be supplied... Michael Murphy, Returning Officer.
