Deed No.245 (folio 13) Country Section 32 Allotment 7 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
Conveyance dated 13 February 1851. Deed registered 08 March 1851. George Hart of Wellington, Gentleman to the Reverend Henry Green of Wellington, Minister of the Primitive Methodist connexion, Robert Lawson, James Tavener, William Thomas and Edward Russell all of the District of the Hutt, farmers. New Zealand Company Land Order No 61 dated 01 August 1839 was transferred from John Hodgson to George Hart and is acknowledged by a land transfer certificate dated 04 June 1850 – register number of transfer 1113. To be held *“upon special trust and to the intent that a Chapel or Meeting House and school shall be erected thereon by the Members of the said Primitive Methodist connexion resident in the District of the Hutt and those only, but such use of the said Chapel or Meeting house and school shall be in conformity with the provisions of a certain Deed poll under the hands and seals of Hugh Bourne, James Bourne and William Clowes”* dated 05 February 1830 *“and enrolled in Her Majesty’s High Court of Chancery in England.”* Signed by William Thomas, George Hart and James Tavener in the presence of Robert Hart of Wellington, solicitor, and Edward Lowe of Wellington, clerk and bookkeeper. Bounded on the north by an intended road running between sections 32 and 35, on the south by other part of allotment 7, on the east by the New Hutt Road, on the west by the Old Hutt Road. Signed by Edward Russell in the presence of Edward Lowe of Wellington, clerk and bookkeeper and Alex Mackay of Wellington, watchmaker. Signed by Robert Lawson in the presence of Henry Buck of Wellington, blacksmith and Richard Kibblewhite of Porirua Road, shoemaker.

Conveyance dated 01 April 1851. Deed registered 09 April 1851. Samuel Deighton of Wanganui, settler to Edward John Eyre of Wellington, Esquire and Lieutenant Governor. New Zealand Company Land Order 553. Land *“in the Valley of the Upper Hutt District”* bounded on the north by the River Hutt, on the east by Section 122, on the south by a block of surveyed land, on the west by Section 120. Signed by Samuel Deighton in the presence of T. E. Grimstone of Wellington, chief clerk, Colonial Secretary’s Office and Robert S. Cheesman of Wellington, solicitor.

Deed No.250 (folio 24) Country Section 120 Hutt District Plan in Deed: No
Conveyance dated 28 February 1851. Deed registered 09 April 1851. Richard John Deighton of Wellington, Native Interpreter to Edward John Eyre of Wellington, Esquire and Lieutenant Governor. Land *“in the Upper Hutt”* bounded on the east by Section 121, on the south by the main road leading to Wairarapa, on the west by Section 119. Signed by Richard John Deighton in the presence of Robert Hart of Wellington, solicitor and Robert S. Cheesman of Wellington, solicitor.

Deed No.268 (folio 69) Country Section 7 Hutt District

Conveyance dated 11 August 1851. Deed registered 04 October 1851. Henry Moreing of Wellington, Esquire to George Moore of Wellington, merchant. New Zealand Company Land Order 33 dated 01 August 1839 to Henry Moreing of London, Esquire. *“And whereas by a certain certificate in writing under the hand of William Wakefield... it was certified that in pursuance of the before mentioned land order the preliminary Country section numbered seven on the surveyor general’s plan of the District of the Hutt river bounded on the north by a main road, on the south by Petoni beach, on the east by section number eight and on the west by section number six had been chosen and selected by the said William Wakefield for the said Henry Moreing such certificate”* dated 28 November 1842.

Deed No.304 (folio 151) Country Section 122 Hutt District

Conveyance dated 27 November 1852. Deed registered 12 January 1853. William Fitzherbert of the Town of Wellington, merchant to the Honorable Henry William Petre of the Valley of the Hutt, Treasurer of the Province of New Munster. Signed by William Fitzherbert in the presence of A. de B. Brandon of Wellington, solicitor and H. Buxton of Wellington, clerk to Mr Brandon.

Deed No.309 (folio 157) Country Section 5 Harbour District

Plan in Deed: Yes

Lease dated 18 Mar 1853 for a term of 21 years at an annual rent of £15. Deed registered 06 May 1853. Ko Te Puni, Ngapaki, Hakopa (Rerewa), Wereta (Pakewa), Harawira, Aperahama (Tuhana), for themselves and others of the Tribe Ngatitawhirikura all of Petoni in the Harbour of Port Nicholson Aboriginal Natives to Augustus Septimus Braithwaite of Wellington, engineer. *“And also all that the right of road or passage at all times and for all purposes to the said land and premises hereby intended to be leased upon and through the section number (8) eight in the same district with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.”* Under the terms of the lease the land was to be *“cleared, cultivate or lay the same down in good grass and manage and use the same land in a good and husbandlike manner.”* Signed by Augustus Septimus Braithwaite in the presence of A. de B. Brandon of Wellington, solicitor and H. T. Kemp of Wellington, Native Secretary. Also signed by the other above mentioned parties and Eratuka Ngataierua.

Deed No.310 (folio 159) Country Sections 6 & 7 Harbour District

Plan in Deed: Yes

Lease dated 18 March 1853 for a term of 21 years at an annual rent of £15. Deed registered 06 May 1853. Manihera Te Ngatoro, Waitara, Matene (Te Tapa), Ko Patera (Te Tapetu), Moihi Puketapu, Moihi Taiata, Te Haeana Rakautara of the Ngatiteuruorangi Tribe, all of Ngahouranga on the harbour of Port Nicholson, Aboriginal Natives to Augustus Septimus Braithwaite of Wellington, engineer. *“And also all that the right of road or passage at all times and for all purposes to the said land and premises hereby intended to be leased upon and through the section number (8) eight in the same district with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging.”* Under the terms of the lease the land was to be *“cleared, cultivate or lay the same down in good grass and manage and use the same land in a good and husbandlike manner.”* Signed by the above named in the presence of A. de B. Brandon of Wellington, solicitor and H. T. Kemp of Wellington, Native Secretary. Also signed – Tamati Mataipu.

Deed No.364 (folio 274) Part of Country Section 178 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
Conveyance dated 31 October 1853. Deed registered 04 February 1854. Robert Park of Wellington, civil engineer to Alexander Dalgity of the valley of the Hutt, labourer and David Dalgity of the valley of the Hutt, labourer. "... agreed to sell to the said Alexander Dalgity for the sum of ninety pounds. Forty five pounds whereof was then paid and the residue was to be paid twelve months from that time and which residue hath since been duly paid... And whereas the said Alexander Dalgity purchased the land for and with the money of the said David Dalgity and hath requested the said Robert Park to convey the same land to him the said David Dalgity accordingly." Bounded towards the north by Crown Land, towards the east by the River Hutt, towards the southwest by other part of Section 178 and towards the northwest by Crown Land. Signed by Alexander Dalgity in the presence of Alexander Milne of Hutt Valley, farmer and John Milne of Hutt Valley, farmer. Signed by Robert Park at Wanganui in the presence of D. S. Durie of Wanganui, resident magistrate and Thomas Waters of Wanganui, merchant.

Deed No.371 (folio 283) Part of Wellington Town Section 531 Plan in Deed: Yes
Conveyance dated 02 April 1851. Deed registered 08 March 1854. Reverend Jonathan Cape of Croydon in the County of Surrey, England, clerk to Reverend Henry Green of Wellington, Minister of the Primitive Methodist Connexion; Richard Kibblewhite of the Porirua Road, farmer; Robert Lawson of the Hutt District, farmer; John Clement of Wellington, labourer; Samuel Crowther of the Porirua Road, stonemason; James Taylor of the Porirua Road, sawyer; John Mitchell of the Porirua Road, farmer; James Tavener of the Hutt District, farmer. New Zealand Company Land Order No 56 dated 01 August 1839 was transferred from Henry Cape who "*departed this life in or about the month of November*" 1846 "*leaving the said Jonathan Cape his heir at law surviving him.*" Bounded on the north by Town Acre 532, on the south by Sydney Street, on the east by land now in the occupation of James Annear and on the west by other parts of Section 531. To be held "*Upon Special Trust, and to the Intent (a Chapel or Meeting House and School having been erected thereon by the Members of the said Primitive Methodist Connexion resident in the District of Wellington and in the neighbourhood thereof) to permit*" its use "*by such persons as do now...*" and "*in conformity with the provisions of a certain Deed poll under the hands and seals of Hugh Bourne, James Bourne and William Clowes*" dated 05 February 1830 "*and enrolled in Her Majesty's High Court of Chancery in England.*" Signed by the written named Jonathan Cape by his Attorney Charles Ernest Von Alzdorf in the presence of Patt Moran of Wellington, waiter and Robert Hart of Wellington, solicitor. Signed by Henry Green in the presence of Patt Moran of Wellington, waiter and Robert Hart of Wellington, solicitor. Signed by Robert Lawson, Samuel Crowther, James Taylor, James Tavener and John Clement in the presence of Robert Hart of Wellington, solicitor and Edward Lowe of Wellington, clerk and bookkeeper. Signed by Richard Kibblewhite and John Mitchell in the presence of George Hart of Wellington, gentleman and Edward Lowe of Wellington, clerk and bookkeeper.

Deed No.377 (folio 290) Part of Country Section 35 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
Conveyance dated 30 March 1854. Deed registered 31 March 1854. John McHardie of the Hutt District, farmer to William Hinkley Webb of the Hutt District, settler. Bounded towards the north and south by other parts of Section 35, towards the east by a private road and towards the west "*by the old line of Hutt Road.*" Signed by John McHardie and William Hinkley Webb in the presence of Robert Hart of Wellington, solicitor and John Hare of Wellington, his clerk.

Deed No. 385 (folio 297) Rangitiki District

Conveyance dated 19 April 1854. Deed registered 10 May 1854. Alfred de Bathe Brandon of Wellington, Esquire to William Fitzherbert of the Hutt Valley, Esquire. "*All that block of land situate in Rangitiki*" containing 624 acres bounded towards the north by waste land, towards the northeast by land belonging to William Fitzherbert, towards the south by land belonging to Donald Ferguson, towards the east by the River Rangitiki, towards the west by waste land. Signed by Alfred de Bathe Brandon in the presence of Henry Bunny of Rangitiki, settler and H. Buxton of Wellington, clerk.

Deed No.386 (folio 298) Rangitiki District

Plans in Deed: Yes

Conveyance dated 20 April 1854. Deed registered 10 May 1854. William Fitzherbert of the Hutt Valley, Esquire to Henry Bunny of the Rangitiki District, Esquire. This conveyance covers four pieces of land. [1] Block II (320 acres) Rangitiki District; [2] Block IV (1060 acres) [3] Block XI (318 acres – Lake Alice); [4] land containing 624 acres Rangitiki District. Signed by William Fitzherbert and Henry Bunny in the presence of A. de B. Brandon of Wellington, solicitor and H. Buxton of Wellington, clerk to Mr Brandon. Also mentioned Algernon Gray Tollemache. Note: The next Deed – No.387 – is a mortgage for the same land – Henry Bunny to William Fitzherbert.

Deed No. 415 (folio 332) Part of Wellington Town Section 208

Plan in Deed: Yes

Lease dated 17 September 1853 for a term of 21 years. Deed registered 25 November 1854. Edward Daniell of the Valley of the Hutt, Esquire to John Johnston of Wellington, merchant. Bounded on the north by the Harbour, on the south by Manners Street, on the east by Lombard Street and on the west by the adjoining section (No.207). Signed by Edward Daniell in the presence of us A. de B. Brandon of Wellington, solicitor and Harry Buxton of Wellington, clerk to Mr Brandon.

Deed No.416 (folio 336) Part of Wellington Town Section 208

Plan in Deed: Yes

Lease dated 06 October 1854 for a term of 21 years. Deed registered 25 November 1854. Edward Daniell of the Valley of the Hutt, Esquire to Robert Jenkins of Wellington, publican. Bounded on the north by Lambton Harbour, on the south by Manners Street, on the east by the adjoining section (No. 209), and on the west by Lombard Street. Signed by Edward Daniell in the presence of James Taine of Lambton Quay, Wellington, merchant and John Benge of Able Smith Street, Wellington, warehouseman.

Deed No.422 (folio 353) Part of Country Section 80 Hutt District

Plan in Deed: Yes

Declaration of Trust dated 11 December 1854. Deed registered 12 December 1854. James McEwen of Wellington, shoemaker to Agnes McEwen of the Hutt District, widow. Bounded towards the north by the other part of the same section, towards the east by a public road, towards the south also by other part of the same section, towards the west by Crown Land. This land was granted to James McEwen after application to Francis Dillon Bell "*the Commissioner for deciding claims to Land under Contracts with the New Zealand Company*" who directed as follows: "*Claimant entitled to a Grant subject to his executing a Declaration that it is subject to the life interest of his mother Agnes McEwen.*" Signed by James McEwen in the presence of Robert Hart of Wellington, solicitor and John Hare of Wellington, his clerk.

Deed No.450 (folio 388) Parts of Country Sections 119 & 128 Hutt District Plan: Yes
Conveyance dated 12 July 1853. Deed registered 01 March 1855. John Downey of the Valley of the Hutt, settler to the Honourable Henry William Petre of the same place. Part of Country Section 119: bounded on the north by the River Hutt, on the south by the Public Road, on the east by land part of the same section belonging to James Brown and on the west by the adjoining section (No.118). Part of Country Section 128: bounded on the north by the Public Road, on the south by the adjoining section number 148, on the east by the adjoining section number 129 and on the west by land of the same section number 128 belonging to James Brown. Signed by John Downey in the presence of R. Barton of River Hutt, agriculturalist and A. de B. Brandon of Wellington, solicitor.

Deed No.459 (folio 401) Part of Country Section 38 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
Deed registered 12 March 1855. "*Aglionby, River Hutt, February 11th, 1851. I hereby undertake to Lease to William Scarrow and George Greeks conjointly a piece of land part of Section No.38 containing about 4 acres more or less partly cleared and partly bush for the term of eleven years on these conditions. The said William Scarrow and George Greeks agreeing to pay me the sum of eight pounds cash as a consideration for the House and the expense of the already cleared land. The rent for the entire piece to be paid yearly and to become due on the 1st January 1852 and each successive year for the period of eleven years. The first five years at two pounds per year. The next five years at three pounds per year. The last one year at four pounds. The piece of land is bounded to the Eastward by the main road, to the northwest by the piece occupied at present by Nathaniel Poole and the back part of McDonogh's Creek and to the southeast by the land occupied by J. Harris. I also engage to furnish the said William Scarrow and George Greeks with a copy of my Lease.*" Signed by J. Stratford and witnessed by John Daysh of River Hutt, settler and W. Moodys of River Hutt, settler. The drawn plan also includes the surnames Wilkie, White and Johnston.

Deed No.460 (folio 402) Part of Country Section 21 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
Conveyance dated 12 March 1855. Deed registered 12 March 1855. The Honourable Henry William Petre of Woburn Farm in the Valley of the Hutt to Daniel Riddiford of Orongorongo, Esquire. Bounded towards the north by other part of section numbered 21, towards the east north east and south east by the second river, towards the south by a public road commonly known as White's line and towards the southwest and west by the River Hutt. Signed by Henry William Petre in the presence of D. Wakefield of Wellington, barrister at law and N. Levin of Wellington, merchant.

Note: The next Deed – No.464 – is a mortgage for the same land – Daniel Riddiford to the Hon Henry William Petre.

Deed No. 471 (folio 415) Part of Wellington Town Section 52 Plans in Deed: Yes
Conveyance dated 12 March 1855. Deed registered 20 March 1855. Edward Daniell of the Hutt Valley, Esquire to Edward Allen Hargreaves of Wellington, merchant. Bounded towards the north Section number 51, towards the south by other part of the same section, towards the east by Nairn Street and towards the west by the Town Belt. Signed by Edward Daniell in the presence of Thomas McKay of the Hutt Valley, baker and Thomas Wilson of the Hutt Valley, bootmaker.

Note: The next Deed – No.472 – is a mortgage for the same land – Edward Allen Hargreaves to George Hunter acting Executor of the last will and testament of Robert Fyfe late of Wellington and of the Kai Koras, master whaler deceased.

Deed No.474 (folio 422) Country Section 83 Hutt District Plans in Deed: Yes
Mortgage dated 04 January 1855. Deed registered 28 March 1855. Pierce Cotter of Wellington, builder to Edwin Meredith of Warehama in the Province of Wellington, Esquire. This mortgage covers two pieces of land. [1] Wellington Town Section 146 bounded towards the north by Ghuznee Street, towards the south by the adjoining acre No.145, towards the east by the adjoining acre No.148 and towards the west by the adjoining acre No.144. [2] Section 83 of the Hutt District bounded towards the northeast by the adjoining section, towards the southeast by a public road, towards the northwest by the River Hutt and towards the southwest by the adjoining section No.82. Signed by Pierce Cotter in the presence of A. de B. Brandon of Wellington, solicitor and J. C. Raymond of Wellington, banker.

Deed No. 489 (folio 438) Two parts of Country Section 25 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
Mortgage dated 03 May 1855. Deed registered 04 May 1855. Peter Laing of Wellington, pastry cook to Edward Daniell of the Lower Valley of the Hutt, Esquire. The two parcels of land are divided from each other by the River called the Okoutu or Second River and contain together thirty acres bounded on the south by Country Section number 21 and on all other sides by the said Okoutu or Second River. The piece on the other side of the Second River is bounded on the east by the Okoutu or Second River, on the north by other part of Country Section 25 and on the west by other part of Country Section 25. Signed by Peter Laing in the presence of A. de B. Brandon of Wellington, solicitor and John King of Wellington, solicitor.

Deed No.491 (folio 442) Part of Country Section 49 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
Conveyance dated 07 May 1855. Deed registered 09 May 1855. Thomas Worsley of the Hutt Valley, settler to William Earp of the Hutt Valley, farmer. Bounded towards the north by other part of the same section, towards the south by other part of the same section granted to William Tandy and George Avery, towards the east by the Hutt Road and towards the west by a Creek. Signed by Thomas Worsley by his mark the Deed having been previously read over and explained to him in the presence of A. de B. Brandon of Wellington, solicitor and George Buck of Taita, River Hutt, publican.

Deed No. 499 (folio 447) Part of Country Section 49 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
Mortgage dated 12 June 1855. Deed registered 12 June 1855. James Williams of the Hutt Valley, farmer and Richard Williams and Benjamin Williams both of the Hutt Valley, settlers to William Knight of the Hutt Valley, farmer. Bound towards the north by Section numbers 52 and 50, towards the southeast by Section numbers 50 and 57, towards the south by Section number 46 and towards the northwest by the Hutt Road except that portion sold to Arthur Hayward. Signed by the above parties in the presence of A. de B. Brandon of Wellington, solicitor and William Henry Stokes of Wellington, clerk to Mr Brandon.

Deed No.530 (folio 484) Part of Country Section 38 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
Conveyance dated 27 August 1855. Deed registered 22 October 1855. Edward Gibbon Wakefield of Wellington, Esquire to William Earp of the Valley of the Hutt, farmer. Bounded on the north by Section 46, on the south by Section 35, on the east by Section 39 and on the west by the public road. Signed by Edward Gibbon Wakefield in the presence of Wilhelm Schmidt of Wellington, servant to E. G. Wakefield and Edward Jerningham Wakefield of Wellington, settler.

Deed No.532 (folio 486) Part of Country Section 38 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
 Deed of Gift dated 24 July 1855. Deed registered 06 November 1855. Edward Gibbon Wakefield of Wellington, Esquire to [*“trustees elected by the Hutt Church committee”*] Reverend Thomas Biddulph Hutton of the Valley of the Hutt, clerk; Joseph Percy, Richard Barton, S. S. Braithwaite, Alfred Ludlam, Henry Collett and Henry Taylor all of the Valley of the Hutt, settlers. *“Whereas the said Edward Gibbon Wakefield out of anxiety for the welfare of the Church and a desire to provide a residence or parsonage house for the Clergyman of the Church of England doing duty for the time being in the said Valley of the Hutt is minded to give a piece of land.”* Bounded on the north by land being part of the said Country Section 38 in the occupation of R. Kibblewhite, on the west by part of the same section occupied by N. Poole and by the new road, on the south by part of the same section occupied by J. Stratford and on the east by part of the same section occupied by N. Poole. Signed by Edward Gibbon Wakefield in the presence of Wilhelm Schmidt of Wellington, servant to E. G. Wakefield and Edward Jerningham Wakefield of Wellington, settler. Signed by Thomas Biddulph Hutton, Joseph Percy junior, Henry Collett and Henry Taylor in the presence of William Corbett of Waiwhetu River, settler and W. Humphries of River Hutt, settler. Signed by Richard Barton, Alfred Ludlam and S. S. Braithwaite in the presence of William Thomas Owen of The Hutt, chemist and J. Manning of River Hutt, labourer.

Deed No.533 (folio 489) Part of Country Section 49 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
 Conveyance dated 01 October 1853. Deed registered 06 November 1855. James Williams of the Hutt District, farmer to Arthur Hayward of the same District, stage van proprietor. Bounded on the north by Country Section 52, on the east by Country Section 50, on the south by an accommodation Road and on the west by the Hutt Road. Signed by James Williams in the presence of Robert Hart of Wellington, solicitor and John Pearse of Wellington, solicitor.

Deed No.539 (folio 496) Parts of Country Sections 12 & 13 Hutt District Plan in Deed: Yes
 Conveyance dated 29 September 1855. Deed registered 09 November 1855. Hart Udy of the Hutt Valley, farmer to William Knight of the same place, farmer. Bounded towards the north by Waiwetu Road, towards the east and southeast partly by a tributary of the Awa Motu or third river and partly by part of Country Section 13 and towards the west by the Awa Motu or third river. Signed by Hart Udy in the presence of A. de B. Brandon of Wellington, solicitor and William Henry Stokes of Wellington, clerk to Mr Brandon.

Deed No.540 (folio 497) Country Section 27 Hutt District Plans in Deed: Yes
 Conveyance dated 25 March 1855. Deed registered 04 December 1855. John Wickham Flower of 17 Gracechurch Street, London, Gentleman to the Honorable Algernon Gray Tollemache of Ham House, Petersham, Surrey. This covers several pieces of land – Wellington Town Sections 541, 269, 533, 228, 316, 287 and 852, Country Section 27 Hutt District and Country Section 40 Kinapore District. Country Section 27 is bounded on the north partly by the Country Section 34 and partly by Crown Land, on the west by a Government Road, on the south by Country Section 23 and on the east by Crown Land. Signed by John Wickham Flower and Algernon Gray Tollemache in the presence of Frederick James Tollemache of Ham House, Petersham, Surrey, Esquire and James Dallas of 17 Grace Church Street, London, clerk to John Wickham Flower.

 Conveyance dated 28 April 1855. Deed registered 11 December 1855. William Swainson, F.R.S., of the Hutt to John Wilkins Marshall, Paymaster of Her Majesty's 65th Regiment of Foot. Bounded towards the west by Porewa Stream and on all the other sides by other part of the said Block. Signed by William Swainson in the presence of Benjamin Buck of The Hutt, surgeon and W. J. Swainson of Rangitiki, settler.

Deed No.546 (folio 505) Part of Wellington Town Section 579 Plan in Deed: Yes
Conveyance dated 28 August 1855. Deed registered 17 December 1855. Hart Udy of the Hutt Valley, wheelwright to Robert Craig of Wellington, brewer.
