Friday – Dent & Walker cutting rods for thatching. Tysack injured his leg.

List of tools at the Motu &c. One pit saw cross cut – and hands in 8 dogs. One squaring axe, one felling axe, three chisels, one hammer, one strover, one Great-foot, two gumblets, one stone, a rope, an oven, a plane, five tarpaulins.

[7] Sketch plan in faint pencil of Nelson? – no date. Shows Nopero's whare and Reserve for Public Offices and Institutions. No other details available.

[8] Note upon Suburban plans as to Road – no date.
Upon Plan of Wakatu or Nelson District North, South, Maitai Valley and Brook Street suburban sections – “The quantity of land in each section is in excess to compensate for any deflection in the course of the Roads which circumstances may hereafter require in reference to facilities of construction.” – signed F. Tuckett, Chief Surveyor. The above in different words occurs thrice on the above plan.

Upon Waimea East plan by which the choices are made – “The quantity of land contained in each section is in excess, to compensate for any possible deflection in the direction of the roads which in reference to facilities of formation may be hereafter found requisite.”

[9] Note - no date, no name. I did ask Pinnock to wait two or three hours for three successive days never supposing that he would claim full payment from the Company. I rather thought that it was a private affair of my own (if he claimed any payment at all) as it was to save myself the trouble of going so often to the Port.
