### New Zealand Gazette and Wellington Spectator 06 Jan 1844 Wanganui

A party of natives agreed with a settler to convey in their canoe forty-three baskets of potatoes to his farm, for which service they requested payment beforehand; this was complied with, because the chief did not wish to go with the party, and desired to share the payment among them. On arriving at their destination, thirty baskets only were delivered, and they were pushing off in their canoe, when the settler asked for the remainder; these they refused, declaring there were no more; on this he jumped on board, and discovered them hid under some mats, he threw three on shore, and the natives (eight in number) then threatened to throw him overboard if he did not immediately retire; he did so, when he was followed by them, and they were about to commence an attack on him with their manouka poles, but hearing him call for **his dog** and a gun, made off, leaving him minus ten baskets.

### New Munster Provincial Ordinance – Dog Nuisance Ordinance 1849

[2] That the owner of any dog or dogs is hereby required, from and after the first day of January 1850 to register the same in a book to be kept for that purpose by the Clerk to the Bench of Magistrates.

[3] Annual fee of 10s per dog

[4] Unregistered dogs may be destroyed by any person belonging to the Constabulary Force

[5] Owners of unregistered dogs are liable for the 10s registration fee plus an additional penalty of 10s per dog

[7] Registration book can be inspected at the Resident Magistrate's court on payment of a fee of sixpence

[9] Upon the requisition of the majority of the Magistrates of any district, the Lieutenant-Governor may proclaim this Ordinance to be in operation

[10] Monies raised to be expended in repairs of roads

[11] Natives not resident in any town, not to be subject to provisions under this Ordinance

### Wellington Independent 12 Nov 1853 Wanganui

A public meeting was held at the Rutland Hotel, Wanganui, on Monday, the 17<sup>th</sup> October, Mr Thomas Waters in the chair, to receive the report of a Committee appointed at a previous meeting, for the purpose of determining on measures for the advancement of the district. The report having been read, and the merits of the proposed measures discussed, it was resolved:- ... [9] Dog Nuisance – That the Act for the suppression of the dog nuisance be brought into operation forthwith, on account of the daily increasing annoyance.

Wanganui Herald 27 Apr 1868 Dog Days

This was the second of the dog days. A host of dog fanciers, numbering twenty-three, appeared this morning to answer the charge of having in their possession dogs that were not registered in accordance with the Act. Only one of them was fined, the other twenty-two pleading either that the “dogs were only pups,” or asserting that the dogs were living upon their charity, and did not belong to them. This last class was compiled of what might be called – public dogs, and were ordered to be destroyed, but the Sergeant asked how it was to be done, as the police could not shoot them on the streets. Are Maori dogs subject to the same regulations as the whiteman’s? If they are, constable Coakley has a fine field of operations before him.

<p><i>Wanganui Herald 20 May 1868 A Settler Drowned at Manawatu</i>  A settler named Robert Waters has been drowned at Manawatu. It appears that the unfortunate man left Foxton township in a canoe accompanied by two other person, with the intention of going to the outer Ferry. He arrived at Mr Langley's Hotel, transacted his business, and started back up the river in the canoe about 11 o'clock at night, accompanied only by his dog. An hour later Mr Langley heard howling, and on calling out, Waters' dog came to him. Suspecting something wrong, search was made, and the canoe found drifting on the other side of the river, Waters having disappeared. The body was discovered on the following morning resting on a mud flat. From the appearance of the clothes it was evident that the faithful dog had tried to save its master by dragging him for some distance. A Bank draft for £30; a cheque for £10, and some silver, were found on the person. An inquest was afterwards held, and the jury returned a verdict of "found drowned," at the same time adding a rider that Mr Langley deserved credit for the exertions he had made. The deceased was buried on Thursday. He had formerly been engaged carrying stores between Wanganui and Patea for the Commissariat, but more recently became a settler in Manawatu, where he had bought land. – <i>Independent</i>.</p> <p><i>Wanganui Herald 02 Jun 1868 A Faithful Animal</i>  Much has been written as anecdote, and to illustrate natural history, of the sagacity of the dog. He is susceptible of fine training, and whether it is what is called instinct, or the exercise of mental power, of the same order as the human, there is not unfrequently produced a sequence of action that affords strong inductive evidence of complexity of ideas. An extraordinary instance of the sagacity and faithfulness of the dog has just come to our knowledge. Two or three weeks ago a man named Waters, who was engaged on the ferry at Foxton, was drowned through falling out of a canoe. The accident occurred after dusk, but it was a beautiful moonlight night. On the night in question the ferryman's dog "Nero" made a most unusual noise at the door of a Mr Langley, who, when he had opened the door, and seen the dog hold up his head and turn his nose in the direction of the river, suspected there was something wrong, and went down to where the canoe was generally stationed, preceded by the dog. The dog left him, and, he, thinking Waters had fallen into the river, returned to his house. The next morning as one of the men, engaged at the ferry, was going down to the river, he met "Nero" coming from it; the dog gave a terrible howling moan, and at once turned his head in the direction of the ferry, whither he proceeded, followed by the man. Waters was found on the bank, his right arm elevated, and his position such as to indicate that he must have been alive since he was on the bank. The dog had dragged him out of the river, the coat on the shoulder being all torn, and the marks of the struggle that had taken place all visible. The faithful creature had remained by his late master's side the whole of the night, and the next morning, when first seen, the water was running from his eyes, as if, susceptible of human grief, he was shedding tears over the inanimate form of his best friend. "Nero" is well known in Wanganui, where he was for some time, when his master was in the Commissariat, and his tractability and intelligence were often the subject of wonder. "Nero" is between a Newfoundland and retriever. We hear his Honor Judge Ward has ordered him to be sent to Wellington to be sold.</p>
