### *Headstone Inscription St Werburgh, Hoo*

In Memory of Elizabeth wife of George Pearce and daughter of George and Elizabeth Gates who died the 29<sup>th</sup> September 1828 in the 51<sup>st</sup> year of her age. A friend, a wife and mother all combined... well be said by those she left behing God grant her... heaven may be increased and may her... all once more her meet in heaven to... and him to greet. Left issue 5 sons and 5 daughters. Also the above named George Pearce who departed this life the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 1845 aged 69 years... to be righteous that it shall be... with him... the wicked... shall be...
