 Captain Eustace Macartney Parsons-Smith, R.A.M.C., died suddenly at Khartoum on May 28<sup>th</sup>, aged 34. He was the youngest son of the late Dr Parsons-Smith of Croydon, and was educated at St. Thomas's Hospital, taking the diplomas of M.R.C.S and L.R.C.P. Lond. In 1908. After acting as clinical assistant in the Children's Medical Department at St. Thomas's, he entered the R.A.M.C. as lieutenant on January 30<sup>th</sup>, 1909, and became captain on July 30<sup>th</sup>, 1912. He joined the Egyptian army – in which he held the rank of Bey at the time of his death – on May 11, 1911, and received the Order of the Nile on August 31<sup>st</sup>, 1917.
