Gravesend Reporter, North Kent and South Essex Advertiser 07 Sep 1861 Case of Mr Tidby's License

This was the day to which the hearing of this case had been adjourned for the purpose of receiving a reply from the Office of Inland Revenue with regard to the letter Mr Tidby had received in March last as to the terms of his license, the hours he might keep open &c. Mr Eyre, solicitor, who appeared for Mr Tidby on the former occasion, was now in attendance, and produced a letter from the Inland Revenue, in which Mr Tidby is informed that the only restriction about opening is that he must not open on Sundays before half-past twelve, nor keep open during divine service, and that the information conveyed to him in the letter of March is correct. Some conversation took place on the subject, at the conclusion of which the bench dismissed the summons.

Maidstone Journal and Kentish Advertiser 27 Mar 1871

A vestry meeting for Gravesend Parish was held on Thursday evening, in the parish church. The meeting was called for the purpose of nominating householders to be returned to the Justices, for their appointment of overseers; of electing Surveyors of Highways for the ensuing year; passing the Surveyors' accounts; and appointing auditors of the watch rate.
