

A social and dance was planned for 22 January 1923 in aid of repairs to Mr Pemberton's motorcar. Charges were set at 5s double 3s Gents single and 2s 6d Ladies single. A Mr N. Craig was invited to provide music, and this may have been Nathaniel Craig Snr or Jnr. The former was a nurseryman in Taita in 1892 and the latter was a draper living on Hutt Road, Lower Hutt in 1922.
