Will dated 24 Oct 1801; Probate granted 19 August 1803

This is the last Will and Testament of me James Agutter of the parish of Saint Paul Deptford in the County of Kent Fellmonger. I desire that I may be reverently buried at the discretion of my executors hereinafter named and that the funeral expenses may be paid within one month after my decease. I give and devise all those my... freehold bonds situate in Mill Lane in the parish of Saint Paul Deptford aforesaid with their appurtenances and... of [my wife Sarah Agutter](#) for and during the Term of her natural life and from and after her decease I give and devise... unto and to the use of [my children Thomas Agutter, James Agutter, Sarah the wife of John Potter](#) of... Street, Bloomsbury in the County of Surrey fellmonger, [Elizabeth the wife Henry Hopkins](#) of the Bart Lane, Deptford in the County of Kent watchmaker, [Mary the wife of John Rout](#) of the Broadway, Deptford, aforesaid, baker and [Susan the wife of Thomas Sloman](#) of the same place Grocer their heirs and assigns for ever equally and to take as tenants in common and not as joint tenants and in failure of issue of any or either of my said children their share of... so dying without issue shall be equally divided between the survivors and survivor of my said children and I give and bequeath unto my said Wife Sarah Agutter the interest dividends and proceeds of three hundred pounds stock in the three per cent consolidated Bank Annuity for and during her normal life and I direct my Executrix and Executor hereinafter named ... an account of all my stock in Trade Book Debts and personal estate (except such part as shall be specifically disposed of by this my Will) and to raise the sum of four thousand pounds out of those... to ... out at Interest and invested in some or one of the public funds or other good security in the names of my said Executrix and Executor upon Trust to permit and suffer my said Wife to receive the Interest Dividends and Proceeds thereof during her natural life but in also my eldest son Thomas Agutter shall have occasion for any part of the said four thousand pounds so to be raised as aforesaid for ...veying on his Business he shall be at Liberty to retain the same in his Business upon paying five pounds per centum per annum Interest and giving such security for the same as shall be approved of by my said wife and from and after her decease I give and bequeath the said three hundred pounds stock and the said four thousand pounds so to be raised as aforesaid unto and amongst all my children to be equally divided between them share and share alike and my Will and Intention is that such share and shares as shall respectively belong to my daughters shall not be subject to the debts engagements or control of their or... of their respective husbands but shall be for the separate and respective use and uses of my said daughters during their respective lives and their Receipt and Receipts alone shall be good and sufficient discharges for the same unto my Executors from time to time notwithstanding their ... and whereas my said children have had already five hundred pounds each for their marriage portion and in case and one of them has had more than that sum advanced or shall in my Lifetime have any more advanced.. or they shall abate in proportion to what shall have been or hereafter may be advanced to them in my Lifetime and in case any of my said children shall die in the Lifetime of my said wife without having any ... then my Will is that... their share or sharessp dying without issue shall be equally divided between the survivors and survivor of them but in case any or other of them shall have died leaving a child or children then such Child or children shall be entitled to the share of his her of their father or mother so dying and leaving issue as aforesaid and my Will and Intention is that my said Wife shall leave the use of my household goods plate linen and China during her life and after her decease to be equally divided between my said children but in case my

son Thomas Agutter shall... to purchase the household goods plate linen and china after my said wifes decease he shall be liberty so to do at a fair valuation and divide the monies in like manner and I desire that my said wife's linen and wearing apparel after her decease shall be divided between my daughters and my own wearing apparel to be divided between my sons (except my Silver watch which I give to [my Grandson James Agutter](#) and I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Agutter the lease of the house yard and premises wherever I reside with the appurts for the Remainder of the Term therein to ... and also my Chaise waggon carts and horses together with all the utensils in Trade to and for his use and benefit and I desire that Mairning Kings may be given to my sons and daughters and my sons in law and to William Watkins of ... Street in the parish of Bexley in the County of Kent and John Talby of Old Ford in the County of Middlesex fellmonger and as to all the Rest Residue and Remainder of my real and personal estate and estates whatsoever and wheresoever not before disposed of I given devise and bequeath the same unto and to the use of my children their heirs executors admon and assigns for ever to be equally divided between them within twelve months after my decease as Tenants in common and not as joint tenants and I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said wife Sarah Agutter Executrix and my said son Thomas Agutter Executor of this my last will and testament and do hereby revoke and make void all former and other wills by me at any time made and do declare this to be my last will and testament. In witness whereof I the said James Agutter the Testator have to this my last will and testament contained in this and the two proceeding sheets of paper set my hand and seal that is to say my hand to the bottom of each of the two previous sheets and my hand and seal to this last sheet herefor **this twenty fourth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one.** Signed James Agutter sealed published and declared by the said James Agutter the Testator as and for his last will and testament in the presence of us who have subscribed our hands as witnesses thereto at this request in his presence and in the presence of each other Thomas Baker, William Baker, Robert Baker.

This will was proved at London on **the nineteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three** before the worshipful Charles Coote Doctor of Laws Surrogate of the Right Honorable Sir William Wynn Knight also Doctor of Laws Master Keeper or Commissary of the Prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the oaths of Sarah Agutter widow the relict of the deceased and Thomas Agutter the son of the said deceased to whom admon of all and singular the goods chattels and credits of the deceased was granted they having been first sworn duly to administer.
