Hutt and Petone News 03 May 1909

From the Wainui-o-mata comes word of the death of Mr W. Burdan, who was one of the earliest settlers in the Wainui Valley. He was born at Lower Hutt 52 years ago, and at an early age removed to Wainui. He leaves a widow and seven grown-up sons and daughters. A memorial service was held in the Wainui Church yesterday afternoon.
