On Saturday the 20th inst., was married, at Marnhull, Henry Cutler, Esq., of London, eldest son of the Rev John Cutler, of Sherborne, to Miss Cole, of the former place.

Salisbury and Winchester Journal 03 Sep 1821

A numerous and very respectable meeting of the Pupils and Friends of the Rev John Cutler, Master of the King's School, Sherborne, took place on Thursday the 23d ult., at the Town Hall, as a mark of respect to him, called for by his long and arduous services.

Salisbury and Winchester Journal 27 Jan 1823

Sherborne, Jan 24. On Tuesday the trustees of our King's School proceeded to the election of a Head Master for that institution; the Rev John Cutler (who for upwards of thirty years had fulfilled the arduous duties of that office with fidelity and honour) having given notice of his resignation from the declining state of his health. There were many candidates on the occasion; but the gentleman chosen as Mr Cutler's successor, is the Rev Ralph Lyon, A.M. of Trinity College, Cambridge, who, we understand, is an erudite and accomplished scholar, and an individual of the highest excellence and worth.
