

*The Morning Chronicle 25 Sep 1837 Refusal of a Church-rate at Stepney*

Pursuant to a notice of the churchwardens of the parish of Stepney, a meeting was held on Saturday morning in the church to make a rate for the necessary repairs of the churches and churchyards. The attendance on the occasion was extremely numerous, in consequence of the proceedings which have recently taken place in the parish for the purpose of imposing a rate against the wishes of a majority of the inhabitants. Mr Robert Willis Hall having been voted to the chair, stated the object for which the parishioners had assembled, in a temperate and conciliatory address, which was listened to with much attention by each party. At the conclusion of the address, he read an estimate which had been made by Mr **Thomas William Dunch**, of the amount requisite for repairing the churches and churchyards. It appeared that that the expense of repairing the tower, *lc.*, of the parish church would be £100 and that £90 were wanted for the necessary repairs of the railings &c. in the church-yard. The repairs of the new church in Turner-street were estimated at £200.... [continues]
