Subscriptions from the Hutt Valley; Collectorate No.4: Taita and Naienaie – George Ebden 5s.

*Evening Post 20 Jun 1863*

Wanted a pair of Sawyers, to cut any amount of Timber on Farm. Good road and plenty of Sale. Ebden's Petoni, Hutt. June 18, 1863.

*Evening Post 11 May 1870 Magistrate's Court*

Cooke v. Wagner – An action to recover damages in the sum of £25, for an assault...George Ebden, sworn, I remember the occurrence between Cooke and Wagner. I heard the latter order Cooke out of the house, and he took up a pair of rusty tongs. I did not see Wagner strike or kick Cooke.

*Evening Post 14 Nov 1878 Magistrate's Court*

There were six civil cases in the list, but only two came before the Court. In J. D. v George Ebden, £5 10s 4d, was adjourned for eight weeks.

*Evening Post 12 Apr 1882 Death*

On the 11<sup>th</sup> April, Hannah, daughter of George Ebden, of the Hutt, aged 29 years.

*Evening Post 20 Oct 1885 Death & Funeral Notice*

On 20<sup>th</sup> October, at the Western Hutt, George Ebden, aged 68 years. The Friends of the late Mr George Ebden are respectfully invited to attend his funeral, which will leave his late residence, at the Western Hutt, at noon on Thursday, the 22<sup>nd</sup>, arriving at the Taita church at 3 o'clock same day.
