Gilson, man-midwife and Susanna Pegge. Registered at Red-cross Street, near Cripple-gate, London 18 Jan 1798

No.288 John Moginie of this parish, widower, and Mary Ann Willcocks of this parish, spinster were married in this Church by Licence 19 Sep 1814. Witnesses Jas. C. Willcocks and Josh. Penny. Bride and Groom signed the register.
