Proceedings of the Old Bailey – John Wainwright, Theft - burglary 17th February 1813 – Reference t18130217-20

John Wainwright was indicted for burglariously breaking and entering the dwelling-house of Samuel Maginie, about the hour of nine in the night, on the 13th January, and stealing therein four silver caddy-spoons, value £1 2s three silver tea-spoons, value 12s, a pair of sugar tongs, value 6s, a silver desert spoon, value 14s and a table-spoon, value 6s his property. Samuel Moginie: I live at No.1 Princes-row, Pimlico, St George's, Hanover-square. I am a watchmaker and jeweler....
