Monumental inscriptions

No 294 Joseph Nash died 5th May 1859 in his 73rd year (inscription evidently worn). Sarah wife of the above and daughter of John Ward late of Newdigate she died 29th October 1839 aged 49. Also Edward Nash son of Joseph & Sarah who died 10 April 1846 aged 23 (in his 23rd year ?)

No 315 Edward Nash died 2 April 1852 aged 63. Also his wife Ann died 30 June 1858 aged 72

No 339 John Ward Nash son of Joseph & Sarah died 28 April 1814 aged 2

No.137 John Crosskey of the parish of Trinity Guildford, bachelor and Caroline Nash of the parish of Capel, spinster were married by Licence with consent of parents 15 Dec 1833 in the presence of Joseph Nash and Emily Nash.
