Contents: By John Scott of Hadham Park, gentleman, and Mary his wife, late Mary Sworder; John Sleape of Theydon Mount Essex, gentleman, and Elizabeth, his wife, late Elizabeth Sworder; and William Yardley of Bishop's Stortford, watchmaker, and Sarah his wife, late Sarah Sworder; (Mary, Elizabeth and Sarah being neices and co-heiresses of William Sworder late of Braughing, gentleman) of land in Maddow Field, [Wyddial,] in the manor of Berkesden to the use of John Thomas Ellis of Wyddial Hall, esquire. The surrender is made at the request of John Chapman of London, tallow chandler, Edmund Chapman of West Wickham, Cambridge, yeoman, Thomas Chapman of London, coachmaker, Alexander Gibbs of London, baker, Peter Ramsey of Bishop's Stortford, brazier, and William Palmer of the same, yeoman, who are entitled to the money arising from the sale of the land under trusts in the will of Mary Chapman, widow, deceased.

Martha Palmer, died 12 Mar 1769, aged 28yrs; William Palmer, Senior, died 13 Jan 1796 aged 62yrs; Thomas Palmer died 16 Mar 1798 aged 35yrs.
