A letter was read from the Mayor of Wellington asking the Land Board to withhold from sale Section 94 Wainuiomata applied for by Messrs J. and D. Sinclair and others – Application No.4563. It was resolved that the receipt of the letter should be acknowledged and the writer informed that further consideration of the matter was postponed pending a report on the nature of the land from the surveyors.

Further correspondence relative to the land from the Mayor of Wellington was read, and after some discussion it was resolved on the motion of Mr Mason that the application of Messrs J. and D. Sinclair to purchase Section 94 Wainuiomata be confirmed.
