1858 Dec 17 David Porter is authorised by Provincial Government to receive applications for land in the Wanganui District; Charles Sharpe, Customs Officer of Wanganui is authorised to receive any sums of money payable on the sale or disposal of the Waste Lands of the Crown.

1859 Feb 26 William Barnard Rhodes and John Gibson Kinross to act as sureties to John E. Smith.

1859 Feb 28 Ralph Joshua Allsworth £50 for purchase of 100a rural land Wanganui.

1859 Mar 12 Wanganui purchasers – Henry Williamson, James McDonald, Charles Vincent proposed purchases contrary to land regulations.
