Memorandum in reference to Certificates issued for Compensation Scrips by the Chairman of the Committee of Resident Land holders in the Wellington settlement on the 31st of December 1850 signed by David Lewis.

Mr F. A. Weld, Preliminary Land Order 122.
150 acres to be issued

Mr E. Jerningham was the original purchaser of this Land order. Mr Jerningham's Assignees transferred to F. A. Weld on 13 Jan 1844. Mr Weld stands at present as the owner in the Company Books.

Donald Gollan, Preliminary Land Order 781
150 acres

Mr William Deans was the original purchaser of this Land order. No transfer recorded from Deans. There is a transfer recorded of the Country Section chosen under this Land order from K. Matherson to Donald Gollan dated 15 Nov 1844. Note written by David Lewis 01 Feb 1851: I find that the Messrs Deans arrangement for an Exchange has no reference to this Land order.

James Petrick, Preliminary Land Order 690
75 acres to be issued on Mr P. giving evidence of transfer to him.

Mr Samuel Revans was the original purchaser of this Land order. Revans transferred to H. Cook who transferred to A. Shand 31 Jul 1840. No transfer recorded to Petrick.

Mr William Bromley, Preliminary Land Orders 266, 280, 405
450 acres to be issued

Mr John Reay was the original purchaser of these Land Orders whose Assignees transferred to William Bromley. They stand at present in the Company's books in the name of William Bromley.

Trustees of Waitt & Tyser, Secondary Land Order 58 Special
150 acres to be issued

Messrs Greenwood, Poole & Richard B. Turner were the original purchasers of this Land order who transferred to Messrs Waitt & Tyser 04 Aug 1841.

Country Land Association (gy who represents them) Preliminary Land Orders 506 and 919
300 acres to be issued to parties entitled, on shewing their identity with the land association.

Mr Robert Few was the original purchaser of Land Order 506 who transferred to Mr D. Wakefield 19 Dec 1840 who again transferred to Mr J. Brander 07 Jan 1841 who also transferred 1/8 of section to Mr John Read 30 Apr 1844. There is also an application from the executor of Mr Brander in England (see 42 [50]) for compensation.

Mr D. Riddiford was the original purchaser of Land Order 919 who transferred to D. McDonald 07 Apr 1842. There is also a transfer of this Land order recorded on 06 Jun 1843 from W. B. Rhodes to W. A. Cooper.

Mr John Wallace, Preliminary Land Order 838
150 acres to be issued

Mr John Nicol was the original purchaser of this Land order who transferred to McLeod who transferred to Messrs Anderson, Crawford & Loxly who transferred to Mr John Wallace.

Mr Richard Baker, Preliminary Land Order 24
150 acres not to be issued. If Mr Baker proves title he would seem to be entitled to 75 acres.

Mr C. Rawson was the original purchaser of this Land Order who transferred to Thomas Parkinson 07 Nov 1840 who transferred to J. T. Hartley 16 Nov 1840 who transferred Harry Hughlings on 11 Feb 1841. It stands in the Company's Books at present as the property of Harry Hughlings and who has actually received a supplementary Land Order for 75 acres as an absentee owner.

Mr John G. Eglington, Heir at law J. Schmidt deceased, Secondary Land Order 50 Special
150 acres not to be issued

Mr John Schmidt was the original purchaser of this Land Order who transferred to Mr Henry Collier on 18 Jul 1845. There is a copy of correspondence in the Office between Mr Collier and the Secretary claiming compensation as an absentee.

Mr John Howard Wallace, Secondary Land Order 39 Ordinary
75 acres to be issued

A Scrip for 150 acres has already been issued for this Land Order to Mr G. Moore. Mr Wallace has since explained that this is an error he having given the number of choice instead of the number of the Land Order. [signed] David Lewis 01 Feb 1851.

Mr W. Deans was the original purchaser of this Land Order. No transfer recorded of the Country Section selected under this Land Order.

Messrs Greenwood & Jackson were the original purchasers of this Land Order who transferred to the three Brothers Greenwood 24 Jan 1843.

Henry Taylor, Preliminary Land Order 846
150 acres not to be issued.

Mr James Forbes was the original purchaser of this Land Order and in whose name it now stands in the Company's books and who moreover has actually received a supplementary Land order for 75 acres as an absentee owner.

Robert Jenkins, Preliminary Land Order 81
150 acres to be issued on proof of transfer

Mr J. W. Child was the original purchaser of this Land order who transferred to Mr Rea. No transfer recorded from Rea to Jenkins.

150 acres to be issued on number of land order being given.

The Clerk of the Company's Land office not having been called before the Committee when the cases were under consideration. The awards appear to have been made in ignorance of many facts which is known to the committee. They would hardly have awarded in favour of the claims. Thus it will be perceived that in respect of some of the landorders the original purchasers have already received absentee scrip. In respect of others the committee has itself previously awarded full or nearly full amount of scrip so that their present awards giving more than 150 acres on a land order are clearly irregular. I think that all the cases in which I have declined to issue scrip ought to be reheard and the Company's late land clerk and Registers examined. Signed W.
