PRO Will of Elizabeth Wyman of Standon dated 10 Sep 1856 – Reference Prob 11/2262

Appoints Brother Richard to be sole executor; “my late sister Ann now deceased wife of Mr George Chambers”; wearing apparel, rings, jewels &c to nieces Ann and Caroline Chambers equally between them. Witnesses: Thomas Mott of Much Hadham, Solicitor; Mary E. Mott of the same place, spinster. Proved December 1857.
